

Culbertson Public School
Indian Education Committee Meeting
06/19/2018

- This meeting was called to order at 5:53 pm in Culbertson Public School cafeteria.
 - We approved last meetings minutes, and the agenda for 6/19/2018 meeting. Leslie motioned this, Lisa seconded, and motion was carried with everyone in favor.
- Financial Report:
 - \$3579.53 in the account. Lisa Motioned to approve this. Andrea Seconded.
- Old Business:
 - We talked about asking the Lions Club to help with school supplies. We are going to write a letter of request. The Lions Club has their meetings in September. So that is when it will potentially get approved or denied. Other community organizations we can ask for donations through to assist the kids are the Woman's Club, and the Cottonwood Club.
 - It was also discussed writing a letter of request through Nike, and Toms. We will be requesting donations for the whole school.
 - We are going to contact the Housing Improvement Program out of Poplar, Mt. They are also known for helping the children.
 - We discussed setting aside money for supplies and emergency funds for the JOM classroom to use just in case the kids need it when school begins. We decided on \$500.00 to go into this fund. Leslie motioned to approve, Lisa seconded. All were in favor, and motion was carried.
 - After school snacks: Leslie has the paperwork for this program, is going to fill it out, and send it in. It will be for all bus kids throughout the school. We discussed having school clubs, or kids who need community service to hand out the snacks after school if this gets approved.
 - Mr. Crowder is here. Thank you!
- New Business:
 - Mr. Crowder handed out 1-04-115 Indian Education Equal Participants to look over. This just got adopted in January. Data assessment and website access to data and minutes is basically all that changed from our recent ones.
 - We discussed having a speaker from a tribe to come to the school once a month and do presentations on that tribe. We would switch tribes every month so that this way the kids know their history and don't feel like they are forgotten. Mr. Crowder will write this proposal up and run it by the school board. Then we will bring a presentation to the next board meeting. Hopefully this will be put in the curriculum for this year and be accepted.
 - We also discussed trying to get a Native American Studies/History class or doing a language class. Lisa motioned this, Leslie seconded it, and everyone approved the new business. Motion was carried.
 - Approval for JOM. We looked over the application, and annual report. Everyone agreed, and Clarice signed so it can be submitted to the JOM manager. This is the Johnson O'Malley application for contract. So, we can have the program we have. Leslie motioned this, and Lisa seconded. Motion was carried.
 - We discussed what to do for Native American Week. We are looking for speakers. We are going to try to get ahold of Lou-Ann Azure and see if someone can come set up

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teepees. We discussed getting a drum group and dancers. All ideas are appreciated! Just let us know if you can think of anything else or would like to help.

- We will now be having a monthly meeting. Lisa motioned this, and Leslie seconded. All were in favor, motion carried. Our next meeting will be July 24th, 2018, 5:30 pm at Culbertson Public School Cafeteria. All parents, guardians, and children are welcome to attend! The July School board meeting will be held Tuesday July 17th, 2018 at 6:30pm. All are welcomed to attend this as well.
