Welcome to Culbertson Public Schools!

We are excited your child will be attending our school. We are all here to help them succeed in every way.

Please fill out all the documents in this packet including the Free and Reduced Lunch Application. This program financially benefits our school if everyone takes advantage of it; but new applications are required every year. The documents are required either by state law or the Culbertson School District to enroll. All information is kept confidential; please return a completed packet for each student in your household. All documents must be complete before your student can be enrolled and/or attend school.

Please also include:

1. Copy of Student's certified birth certificate – **Only if registering for Kindergarten or new transfer student**
2. Copy of Student's social security card – **Only if registering for Kindergarten or new transfer student**
3. Copy of Student's Immunization (Copy is fine) – **Only if registering for Kindergarten /new transfer student/ any updated immunizations done**
4. If you have chosen NOT to vaccinate your student, an exemption form must be completed and notarized **yearly**. Please see office for this form; must be turned in before the student can attend school.
5. If you are not the birth parent, please submit documentation showing you are the student's legal guardian. In the case of divorce, provide court documents showing custodial parent or joint custodial. (notarized statements are unacceptable)

The student handbook is found online on our school website. (www.culbertsonschool.com) Please review the handbook with your son or daughter. Please note that the handbook includes the school calendar, bell schedules, and guidelines for academic and behavioral success.

Culbertson School has approximately 300 students in grade K-12. Our school day runs from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., except on Fridays when we dismiss at 3:00 p.m., or on special days when we dismiss early. Our Elementary uses AIMSWeb for student monitoring and the Accelerated Reader Program. Secondary students can participate in activities such as FFA, Speech & Drama, school play, Explore America, Band, and Choir. We offer many sports for students in grades 5-12. Additional assistance is available at any time from our teachers and support staff.

We are looking forward to a great year and encourage you to participate in your child's education. Research indicates that when a parent takes an active interest in their child's education, the child does better in school. Feel free to contact us or to visit your child's classroom whenever possible. All teachers are available from 8:00 to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:30 to 4:00 p.m. every day in addition to their prep period.
