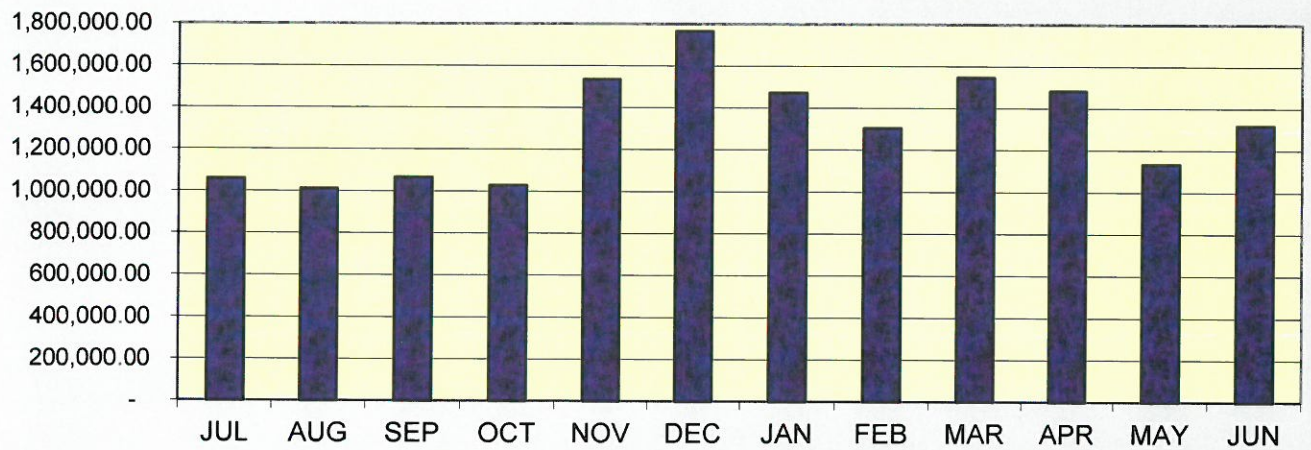
2014-15 INVESTMENTS

Culbertson Board of Trustees:

Elementary basketball is now in progress with 16 girls and 15 boys participating. High school basketball is in full swing. The boys team at the time has a 7-1 record for third in the district and the girls are 2-6 for sixth in the district.
